- College of Arts and Sciences students who are proposing a personal major as an alternative to a traditional academic degree program must complete this form and submit a proposal to the Dean's Office.
- Proposals must specifically state the goals to be achieved through the personal major program, explain why these goals cannot be met with standard major options, and include an outlined proposed curriculum that will be followed.
- Additional policies and procedures regarding proposal protocols are available through the CAS Dean's office.
- **To be eligible for consideration of a personal major, students must:**
  - Be in their second year of study.
  - Have a minimum 2.50 overall GPA.
